On Sunday, October 26<sup>th</sup> the faith community of St. Frances will mark 4 years (or *1,461 days, 35,064 hours or 2,103,840 minutes*) in vigil! The Friends of St. Frances will celebrate this milestone - a journey of faith and justice, on Sunday, October 26<sup>th</sup> with a 10:00AM lay led Communion Prayer Service.

This journey, a span of time no one could have anticipated has been sustained by faith and hope. As was the inspiration of St. Frances X. Cabrini, "I can do all things in Him who strengthens me." (Phil. 4:13) that too has inspired this faith family to remain steadfast in their mission for justice.

As we continue to walk this journey of faith our arms and hearts remain extended to the Archdiocese of Boston. We pray for the Archdiocese of Boston as they continue to suffer through financial disaster, in no small part created by the sexual abuse crisis, that has ongoing immeasurable consequences, such as the clergy pension fund running out of money at an accelerated pace and the good priests that this will ultimately affect. We hold ourselves out to help them resolve the many issues confronting them today.

As from the inception of our vigil we have stated. "we are looking for a fair and equitable solution for both the Archdiocese of Boston and the faith community of St. Frances". Over the past four years we have remained committed to this end result, as we have placed proposal after proposal on the table seeking a win-win solution.

Our thoughts and prayers go out to the other vigil churches as they also close in on their 4 years of resistance against unjust, unfair and unwarranted church closings.

We with Christ's guidance will stand firm in our resolve to protect our community of faith and others that may find themselves at risk.

We remain prayerful; even if it takes another 4 or 44 years that together we can reach a resolution for the greater good of the Church.
